character and nature of our God, Jesus Christ


What are we to prophesy? Our Testimony and the power of the Blood

LUKE 2:12

Identified Jesus

Jesus our Saviour in which the Angels also called Emmanuel. In literal translations means GOD WITH US. so....Jesus is GOD WITH US.

The shepherds immediately identified Jesus even as a baby as their God. They told everyone they saw and met what the Angels had proclaimed to them.

If these Shepherds could identify Jesus as their God then, what is our problem today?

Jesus is the Name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit, these other three are titles. Therefore when Identifying our God as Jesus we are submitting to the scripture Matthew 28:19

MATTHEW 16:16

Peter

"You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." Peter was given the revelation that Jesus was the Son of the Living God and explained this further in his first sermon after Jesus had died and rose again to Heaven. Leaving with Peter Himself on Earth still through the Holy Spirit. This being a greater gift because Jesus was not now confined to a body but could live inside each and everyone of us that welcomed this gift into our lives!

Jesus says to Peter "And I will give you the keys to the kingdom of Heaven, and whatever you bind on earth will be bound in Heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in Heaven."

Peter goes on to declare all that Jesus revealed to him in Acts 2....specifically in Acts 2:38. Affirming what Jesus revealed to him regarding the Oneness of His God. Becoming intimate by knowing who Jesus was then boldly prophesying and submitting under Him as His one true God.

Two Criminals on the Cross

These two men were spiritually and physically falling to pieces. They were at the end of their lives but even still one was able to receive the discovery of who Jesus is and began an intimate relationship with God

The Scriptures tell us that the first criminal called Jesus Lord asking "Lord, remember me when You enter Your Kingdom." saying "Do you not even fear God?" to the other criminal. The first criminal became intimate with Jesus in this moment, understanding that He was surely the God of all creation. The criminal acknowledged that it was Jesus' Kingdom. This lead him to a place where in his last few moments he entered into the kingdom of God. This is because he knew who Jesus was leading to intimacy, prophesy then submission.

It's important to seek out who Jesus is and what He has spoken that we may also join Him in His kingdom. John 3:5

LUKE 24:38

Doubting Disciples

Jesus had revealed the plan of Salvation to His disciples many times. Telling them of His death, burial and resurrection. They had seen all the signs that were prophesied and follow and come to pass, yet they still doubted.

It was only when their eyes were opened that they understood what the bible was teaching. Interesting to note one of the topics Jesus brings up in Luke 24:46-47. *Then He said to them, "Thus it is written, and thus it is necessary for the Christ to suffer and to rise from the dead the third day, "and that repentance and remission of sins should be preached in His name to all nations, beginning at Jerusalem."*

They were to wait in Jerusalem for power from on high, the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit brought on further Intimacy with God as He was then living inside of them. This is when they became completely sold out for Jesus. Joel 2:28 *"And Afterword, I will pour out my Spirit on all people. Your sons and daughters will prophesy, your old men will dream dreams and your young men will see visions."*

PSALM 23

David

David had one of the most expressive relationships with God that we see in scripture. His Psalms inspired by God are relatable to each and everyone of our experiences in this life and our relationships with God. Someone who seems so close to God should know Him pretty well I would think.

David walked in the overflow, in the anointing God has for us and this is what broke all of his chains. Allowing God to get closer to David. in English?
